Greetings fellow flute playing enthusiasts. I hope you are enjoying your summer and making time everyday to play your flute(s).

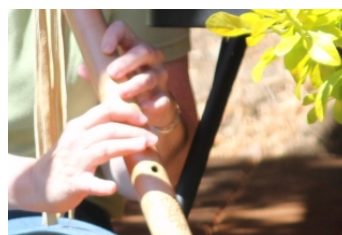
This month's newsletter includes information on some interesting facebook pages, a review of a great book to help you explore your playing, some tips for playing, a tip for storing your flutes.

Often when we are learning new things, we get stuck in the same patterns. Here are a few tips that can help you develop a deeper connection to the range of sounds you can created on your flute.



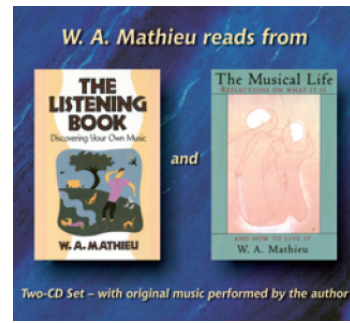

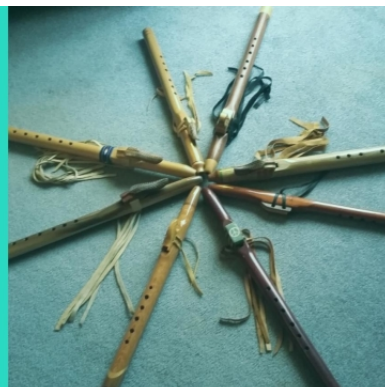
Flute Playshop - September 9
